Tucked into the east-facing slopes of Mount Lofty, Hardy's Verandah Restaurant is home to a curated collection of fine wines. Our wine list celebrates the rich history of Australian winemaking, showcasing the evolution of grape varieties in South Australia and the diverse styles they inspire.

Founded by Arthur Hardy in 1852, Mount Lofty House was home to the first vineyards in the Adelaide Hills—then the highest in South Australia. By 1858, around seven acres were planted with Red Madeira, followed by Cabernet, Shiraz, and Riesling across an additional nine acres, with walnut trees scattered throughout. We honour this rich winemaking legacy by sharing our full collection, stored in ideal natural conditions beneath the restaurant in when the cellar was added.

We are passionate about all things local, with a special focus on South Australia's rich winemaking heritage. Thanks to its Mediterranean climate, fertile soils, and deep-rooted traditions, South Australia has become a leading wine region. Grape cultivation began in the 1830s with immigrant families, and the founding of the South Australian Company in 1836 spurred further growth—laying the foundation for iconic regions like the Barossa Valley, Clare Valley, and Adelaide Hills. We're very pleased to offer a real focus about the diversity of our region by highlighting their two subregional Geographical Indications as Lenswood and Piccadilly in our wine list.

Our wine selection tells the story of winemaking in Australia, alongside a curated range of international wines for context and comparison. From the classic elegance of Bordeaux to the bold, fruit-driven styles of California, our list invites wine lovers to explore the diversity of global grape varieties and deepen their appreciation of Australian wine.

Join us at Hardy's Verandah Restaurant for a journey through Australia's winemaking history, as we honour the pioneers who shaped the wines we enjoy today. Our wine selection is thoughtfully paired with modern South Australian cuisine crafted by our kitchen team. THE ICONS

Here at Mount Lofty we believe everyone deserves a chance to drink the best, we are proud to maintain a selection from some of the greatest and most revered producers in South Australia. We have developed a premium by the glass program to showcase some of these outstanding expressions. All these icons are poured via Coravin to preserve the organoleptic characteristics of our wines.

- 1999 Jim Barry *Lodge Hill* Riesling, Clare Valley SA 59 ▼
Clare Valley is considered by many to be the premier region for Riesling production; Jim Barry is one of the producers at the forefront of the region in terms of quality. This a brilliant chance to try a textbook aged Riesling from the Clare Valley. All the beautiful tertiary characters from extended aging paired with lively acidity and orchard fruit.
- 2017 Penfolds *Yattarna Bin 144* Chardonnay, Tasmania, Tumbarumba, Adelaide Hills 105 ▼
Usually known as one of greatest red wine makers in the country, Penfolds white wines are criminally underrated relative to its red brethren. Yattarna is widely considered one of Australia's finest Chardonnay, often referred to as the White Grange. Yattarna is an Indigenous Australian word meaning little by little, representing the 144 trials conducted to develop the wine.
- 2018 Alkina *Polygon 5* Grenache, Barossa Valley SA 135 ▼
A striking expression of Barossa Grenache from one of the region's most innovative terroir-driven estates. Bold yet finely detailed, this is a profound single-site Grenache with remarkable precision and longevity.
- 2015 Charles Melton *Nine Popes* Grenache Shiraz Mataro, Barossa Valley SA 95 ▼
Charlie Melton is one of Barossa's winemaking pioneers. Nine Popes is his tribute to Châteauneuf-du-Pape and the GSM blend that helped reshape Barossa's approach to grape selection.
- 2021 Henschke *Mount Edelstone* Shiraz, Eden Valley SA 99 ▼
Mount Edelstone, meaning "gemstone" in German. Made by the Henschke family for over 65 years, it's one of Australia's longest continuously produced single-vineyard wines.
- 2015 Henschke *Hill of Grace* Shiraz, Eden Valley SA 450 ▼
Hill of Grace is a historic single vineyard located across from an old Lutheran church, named after Gnadenberg in Silesia—meaning "Hill of Grace." Made entirely from pre-phylloxera Shiraz, a true South Australian legend in a glass.
- 2019 Penfolds *St Henri* Shiraz, Barossa Valley McLaren Vale Eden Valley, Port Lincoln SA 85 ▼
The understated counterpart to Grange, St Henri is perhaps one of Penfolds' most underrated Shiraz wines. Made without any new oak and matured in large old vats. Honest, and full of character.
- 1994 Wendouree Cabernet Sauvignon Malbec, Clare Valley SA 155 ▼
A cult classic from one of Clare Valley's most revered and tightly allocated producers, Wendouree's Cabernet Malbec is celebrated for its uncompromising traditional style and extraordinary longevity. Drawn from some of the region's oldest dry-grown vineyards.
- 1924 Seppeltsfield *100-Year-Old Para Vintage Tawny*, Barossa Valley SA (10ml) 250 ▼
We're proud to offer a taste of history. In 1878, Benno Seppelt began what would become the world's longest running collection of vintage fortified wines. Each year, Seppeltsfield releases a small amount of its 100-year-old Para Vintage Tawny. The 1924 vintage is rare and full of character — rich and intense with notes of leather, cocoa, and tobacco, yet surprisingly fresh and balanced. Its long, lingering finish is a testament to its quality. We're honoured to pour this for you.

SPARKLING WINES

Mount Lofty Estate is home to the highest vineyard in the Adelaide Hills, sitting 650 metres above sea level. We grow Chardonnay from a single clone and Pinot Noir from three clones on our southeast-facing lawns. In partnership with Xavier Bizot of Terre à Terre and DAOSA, he brings expertise from the Bollinger Champagne family. Each vintage reflects the season, and we're proud to present the vintage of 2022; a blend of 69% Pinot Noir and 31% Chardonnay, aged on lees for over two years with a low dosage of 4g/l. 'The Estate' is a limited-edition wine, available exclusively at Mount Lofty House.

France's most iconic wine region—Champagne, long a symbol of celebration and luxury—is experiencing a revival. Once dominated by the large Champagne houses (Grandes Marques), the region is now seeing a surge of independent grower-producers. Instead of selling their grapes to the big names, these growers are crafting their own unique, terroir-driven Champagnes. Known as Grower Champagne, this movement brings fresh energy to tradition, blending modern thinking with deep regional roots.

Very low yields, old vines, only great sites, perfectly ripe fruit, extended lees aging, very low or no dosage and no fining and/or filtration are all decisions taken because Egly believes that they allow his terroir to speak most clearly.

GRAPES OF MEDITERRANEAN ORIGIN

Wines from regions like the South of France, Italy, and Spain offer incredible versatility, and their styles have become increasingly popular in recent years. Varietals like Marsanne, Roussanne, Grenache Blanc, Picpoul, and Vermentino (Rolle) remain underrated, yet offer excellent value. These grapes also have a rich history—Tahbilk in Central Victoria has been working with Marsanne since the 1860s, using cuttings first planted in the Yarra Valley in the 1830s. The rise of these alternative varietals gained momentum in the late 20th century, influenced by European—especially Italian—migration, which helped shape the diverse Australian wine scene we know today.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, SÉMILLON AND BLENDS BEYOND

Sémillon arrived in Australia in 1832 with James Busby's vine collection and found a home in the warm, humid Hunter Valley. Early on, it was often mislabelled as Riesling, Hock, or even Chablis. Its true potential became clear when Maurice O'Shea planted the Lovedale Vineyard in 1946, helping Sémillon rise in popularity. In recent years, aged Sémillon, blends with Sauvignon Blanc, and sweet Botrytis styles have made it one of Australia's most exciting white wines.

Sauvignon Blanc has been in Australia since the 1800s, but its popularity took off in the 1990s. Inspired by the success of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc in New Zealand, the Australian market saw rapid growth in demand.

RIESLING RENAISSANCE

Riesling was first brought to Australia by William Macarthur and planted at Camden Park in South Australia. Key figures like Johann Gramp (Barossa, 1847), Joseph Gilbert (Pewsey Vale, 1850), Alfred Basedow, Rudi Kronberger, and Colin Gramp played major roles in shaping its future—introducing innovations like cool-climate plantings and temperature-controlled fermentation.

As fine table wine evolved in Australia, Riesling gained popularity. However, during the 1960s and 1970s, many sweet wines were falsely labelled as Riesling, which impacted its reputation. By the 1980s, Chardonnay became more popular, pushing Riesling aside. Thanks to passionate producers like Grosset, Jim Barry and Howard Park as well as support from larger wineries, Riesling has made a strong comeback and is now one of Australia's most important white grapes.

CHARDONNAY: SUNSHINE IN BOTTLE

Chardonnay's origins in Australia date back to the 1820s, but it wasn't until the late 1960s that it gained serious attention. In 1969, the Chardonnay vines at Craigmoor in Mudgee were recognized as some of the best European clones. Murray Tyrrell, working with winemaker Pieter van Gent, helped establish Chardonnay as a stand-alone varietal in the Hunter Valley. In 1972, David Wynn planted the first cool-climate Chardonnay in Eden Valley, and by 1979, Brian Croser identified Adelaide Hills as an ideal region for the grape—shaping a more terroir-focused approach.

The 1980s saw a boom in rich, oaky Chardonnays, which led to backlash and the “Anything But Chardonnay” (ABC) movement. By the 2000s, winemakers shifted to more refined styles that expressed the grape's true character and origin.

Globally, Chardonnay has been cultivated since the 12th century, with Burgundy considered its birthplace. The grape's versatility is seen in styles ranging from crisp and unoaked to richly oaked and full-bodied. California is often all seen as another new world mecca for chardonnay.

Adelaide Hills

We are proud to demonstrate the diversity and versatility of the Adelaide Hills; there are two recognised sub-geographical regions. One being Lenswood and the other the Piccadilly Valley, while both are celebrated for their cool-climate viticulture, they are recognized as distinct sub-regions due to their unique micro-climates and rare soil profiles

Lenswood:

This unique single site cumulating at 400 to 600 metres of altitude is bringing texture and salinity rather than purely fruity characteristic. The soils are complex and variable with a mix of sand loam to clay loam and some schist quartz and ironstone as a rock and mineral base.

For Michael Hill Smith, “more intensity of fruit expression, along with more mineral characters and tension associated with the higher acidity.”

The international journey of Chardonnay, the most widely planted white grape globally, is much older than Australian wines. The earliest documented mention of the grape goes back to the 12th century. There are multiple expressions of Chardonnay ranging from unoaked and vibrantly crisp, to subtle oak and easily approachable, to rich oak and deep concentration, that showcases the versatility Burgundy has to offer with the same varietal. Even with Burgundy considered the birthplace of the grape, there has been a considerable amount of work done across the world to showcase regional expressions. It was in 1976 during the judgement of Paris, that Chateau Montelena 1973 brought the limelight on new world Chardonnay. We however, showcase some of the oldest and most celebrated Chardonnay expressions from Burgundy and the rest of the world to showcase the adaptability of the varietal.

SKIN-CONTACT WINES

These wines are a perfect example of old traditions making a comeback. Skin-contact wines have gained popularity with the rise of organic and biodynamic practices, driven by climate change awareness. Winemaking dates back 8,000 years to Georgia, where grape colour mattered less than flavour and alcohol. Today, countries like Georgia and Armenia lead the revival of traditional methods using skin contact and clay vessels (qvevri). Regions like Jura in France, Sicily, and even California have embraced and evolved the style. Australia, known for innovation, has also embraced this movement. Pioneering winemakers like Vanya Cullen and Kathleen Quealy have helped redefine how white grape varieties can be expressed through skin-contact winemaking.

It first appeared in Australia in the 1970s, with plantings in the Hunter Valley by Len Evans in 1976. Since then, it has gained popularity in cool climate regions like Adelaide Hills, Geelong, and Beechworth. Once under the radar, Gamay is now making waves.

In France, Beaujolais has become a hub for natural winemaking, with a growing focus on showcasing terroir through Cru Beaujolais wines, with a recent and fascinating emergence of that variety in Savoy.

PINOT NOIR: THE DIFFICULT DARLING

Pinot Noir is a beloved grape in Australia, though its history here is relatively short. Although it was first brought over in the 1830s, it wasn't until the 1920s that Maurice O'Shea in the Hunter Valley began producing it seriously. Later, producers like Yarra Yering, Tyrrell's, Stephen George, Mark Whisson, Lindsay Barratt, and Best's in Great Western helped the grape gain traction, especially in South Australia. Today, regions like Tasmania, Yarra Valley, Geelong, and Mornington Peninsula are known globally for their distinct, terroir-driven Pinot Noirs.

The King of Burgundy

Pinot Noir's roots go deep in Burgundy, France, where Cistercian monks in the Middle Ages cultivated it with devotion, believing that hard work in the vineyard brought them closer to God. Despite the region being off major trade routes, they focused on quality, laying the foundation for the concept of *terroir*. The grape has been documented there since around 1000 AD. Even Pope Urban V once refused to leave Burgundy, famously saying, "You can't get wine like this in Italy." MEDIUM BODY: JUICY AND SPICY

Throughout the 1900s, adventurous winemakers in Australia explored a wide range of grape varieties. For most of the century, the industry remained focused on classic French grapes and fortified wines. However, by the late 1980s, a shift began. Driven by a desire to create wines with their own identity, winemakers started moving away from traditional bold reds and light Pinot-style wines, giving rise to a new generation of food-friendly, expressive wines.

THE NOBLE NEBBIOLO

Nebbiolo is like a magician—you never quite know what to expect. It's a complex and surprising grape that doesn't have a long history in Australia. First planted in the warmer Mudgee region by Carlo Corino in the 1980s, it found its real home in Australia's cooler climates. Sun-loving yet delicate, Nebbiolo gained traction thanks to pioneers like Pizzini in King Valley and SC Pannell in the Adelaide Hills. As Australian tastes shifted toward cool-climate wines, Nebbiolo began to shine.

Piedmont

The name Nebbiolo comes from “Nebbia,” the Italian word for fog—fitting for its native Piedmont, where autumn fogs blanket the vineyards at harvest time. This grape is behind the famous wines of Barolo and Barbaresco, two regions with distinct styles that have captured the hearts of wine lovers worldwide. Though it makes up only 8% of Piedmont's grape plantings, Nebbiolo is highly respected for its depth and character.

GRENACHE: THE PHOENIX HAS RISEN

Grenache was one of the 363 grape varieties brought to Australia in the Busby collection. It adapted well and thrived in the Mediterranean climate of McLaren Vale, South Australia. Originally, it was mainly used for fortified and bulk wines and rarely mentioned on labels.

In the late 1980s, winemakers like Charlie Melton helped revive interest by showcasing Grenache's potential, especially in Rhône-style blends with Mourvèdre (Mataro) and Shiraz—creating the now-famous GSM blend. Thanks to this renewed appreciation, some of the world's oldest Grenache vines are still thriving in South Australia today

McLaren Vale

Only a 30-minute drive from Mount Lofty, McLaren Vale is a rich and diverse wine region influenced by its mediterranean climate, with some warm summers, mild winters and moderate rainfall ensuring reliable and consistent ripening. All these factors together can be perceived in one word: Elegance.

GSM: GRENACHE SHIRAZ MATARO, THE NEW CLASSIC FROM THE SOUTHERN RHONE

In Australia, especially in Barossa Valley and McLaren Vale, GSM blends are fuller, richer, and fruitier. Grenache is juicy, Shiraz adds bold spice, and Mourvèdre (also called Mataro) gives earthy flavour. These wines are often smoother and easier to drink. The Rhône Valley in France is where the GSM blend (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre) began. These wines are elegant, earthy, and balanced. Grenache gives red fruit, Syrah adds spice and body, and Mourvèdre brings depth. They're usually lower in alcohol and show a clear connection to the land

Once the most widely planted varietal, Grenache is claimed by both Spain and Italy on the island of Sardinia; but its exact origins are uncertain. It is said to have first been cultivated in the 14th century and then gradually spread outwards from the province of Aragon across to Northern Spain and Southern France. Its planting in south of Rhône is what set the stage for Grenache globally. For some time in 17th century, Burgundians were guilty of blending Grenache from the neighbouring Rhône region to improve the flavour of their Pinot Noir. Of course, at the time adding wine from different regions wasn't illegal.

SHIRAZ: AN AUSTRALIAN LEGEND

Shiraz has been part of Australia's wine story since the early 1800s, when vine cuttings—some from the Rhône Valley—were brought to New South Wales and spread to regions like Hunter Valley, Barossa, McLaren Vale, Nagambie Lakes, and Great Southern. Some of the vines planted back then still produce grapes today, making them the oldest continuously producing Shiraz vines in the world.

In the 1830s, Christian Auricht founded Barossa's first trading village, Langmeil, where the famous 'Freedom' vineyard was planted in 1843. In the 1860s, Tahbilk established vineyards in Nagambie Lakes, and Henry Best planted Shiraz in Great Western in 1867—both still producing top wines. Visionaries like Johann and Cyril Henschke pioneered single vineyard, single varietal Shiraz in the cooler Eden Valley, while Max Schubert put Australian Shiraz on the world map with Penfolds Grange.

In the 2000s, Australia gained global recognition for both its bold warm-climate Shiraz and its refined cool-climate Syrah, highlighting regional character and varietal quality. Shiraz remains a symbol of Australia's wine heritage and evolution.

Bordeaux's winemaking history dates back to ancient Roman times, around the 1st century AD. Its rise to fame began with the 12th-century marriage of Eleanor of Aquitaine to England's future king, Henry Plantagenet—putting Bordeaux wine, or "Claret," on the English map. Over the centuries, Bordeaux evolved through Dutch innovations in the 16th century, the 1855 classification system, and challenges like the Phylloxera outbreak. A major turning point came with critic Robert Parker's praise for the 1982 vintage, boosting global attention and reshaping the market. Today, Bordeaux blends tradition with modern technology, and its influence remains so strong that the success of its futures campaign can impact wine pricing worldwide.

The Suppin Rumiko no Sake is made with Hattan Nishiki rice grown locally by a contracted farmer. It has lovely earthy notes, a soft textural palate, balanced acidity and a dry and layered finish.
